The excellent line-up includes Yorkshire born, international soprano Sarah Fox and the welcome return of Peter Auty, tenor, Michael Dewis, baritone, with the Classics Concert Orchestra conducted by Tecwyn Evans (Opera North).

Recognised as an important part of the musical calendar, Classics consistently produces a quality show of operatic favourites, magical movie medleys and magnificent anthems. This year promises to be no exception!

Some firm favourites will be rounded off by the ultimate prom crowd pleasers of Pomp and Circumstance and Rule Britannia, in readiness for fanatical flag waving, reaching a climactic finish with a fantastic fireworks finale.

Last year, the concert played to a capacity crowd of just over three thousand and organisers are advising fans to book tickets early to avoid disappointment.

What is the Daisy Appeal?

The Daisy Appeal needs to raise £6.5 million to build the Hull and East Yorkshire Medical Research and Teaching Centre on land at Castle Hill Hospital, in Cottingham, Hull.

The appeal was launched in 2002 by Professor Stafford and a team of leading consultants in the city. The centre will be used in the first instance for medical research and clinical trials into cancer and heart disease. These are life threatening illnesses that affect every family in some way and are the two biggest killers in the region. The centre will benefit patients living in East Yorkshire, North Yorkshire and North Lincolnshire.
